## **300 YD. RIFLE RANGE RULES**

### **General Range Rules:**

1. Always point the muzzle of a firearm in a safe direction.
2. Keep your finger off the trigger until ready and safe to fire.
3. Firearms must be unloaded until you are ready to shoot.
4. Know your target and what is beyond.
5. Be sure the gun is safe to shoot.
6. Know how to use the gun safely.
7. Use only the correct ammunition for your gun.
8. Wear eye and ear protection.
9. Never use alcohol or drugs before or while shooting.
10. Store guns so that they are not accessible to unauthorized persons.
11. No shooting before 9:00 AM.
12. No handling of weapons whenever anyone is forward of the firing line.
13. Target bullseyes must be 5 ½ feet above the ground to ensure impact on the backstop.
14. Observe all posted rules at ranges.

### **Specific Rules for 300-yd. Range**

1. All shooting must be done from the benches at the firing point and through the "no blue sky tubes". Firing from any other location/position is not allowed.
2. When driving/walking to the firing point, stay as far right as possible.
3. Vehicles are permitted down-range, when the range is clear and safe, for the purpose of setting up and retrieving targets. The access road for this purpose is located on the left side of the range and vehicles must stay on that road. Driving directly to the target berms is not allowed.
4. All vehicles must be parked behind the firing point when the range is hot.

Violations of these rules should be reported to the club management. Violators may be dismissed from club membership.

These rules are reviewed annually by each range Committee Chairman. Any suggestions or recommendations to make our club safer should be directed to any member of the club management team.
