## Rules for Use of Shotgun Patterning Board

- The purpose of this board is to perform **shotgun shell patterning only**. No slugs. No Rifle. No pistol. No black powder. No pellet gun. No BB guns.
- Firing at this board is limited to shotgun shells loaded with non-plated, lead shot only. Shells are limited to a shot size of #2 shot, or smaller, with a Dram equivalent of 3 ¼ or less.
- Minimum firing distance from the board is 15 yards.
- The board is aligned to the center of the trap field shot fall area and safety fan. You must orientate your barrel square to the board. No angle shots permitted.
- Barrel must be stationary and aimed at the center of the board prior to discharging the round. No swinging or sweeping type motion of the gun, outside of the dimensions of the board, is allowed.
- Eye and ear protection is required.
- The board may not be used when any of the Trap fields are in use. Coordination with informal trap field users, on site, during non-scheduled trap shooting, prior to going down range, to the Patterning Board area, is required.
- Please do not leave any target material, or trash of any type, when you have finished using the patterning board.
- Any Club member is authorized, and encouraged, to make on the spot corrections to any shooter not abiding by these rules. Report violations to any Club Officer or Board Member.
- The club has invested significant time and money to provide this addition to our facilities. Please abide by the rules of use above, and this board will provide many, safe, years of service.
