PISTOL RANGE RULES

The following general range rules apply to all users of the pistol range. Specific, detailed, rules are at the range. These rules are meant to enhance health and safety of range users, range supervisors and persons nearby.

Rules:

1. **ALLOWED FIREARMS: HANDGUNS AND .22 cal. RIM-FIRE RIFLES ONLY.**
2. Always point the muzzle of a firearm in a safe direction.
3. Keep your finger off the trigger until ready and safe to fire.
4. Firearms must be unloaded until you are ready to shoot.
5. Know your target and what is beyond.
6. Be sure the gun is safe to shoot.
7. Know how to use the gun safely.
8. Use only the correct ammunition for your gun.
9. Wear eye and ear protection.
10. Never use alcohol or drugs before or while shooting.
11. Store guns so that they are not accessible to unauthorized persons.
12. No shooting before 9:00 AM or after 9:00PM.
13. Before anyone may go forward of the firing line, all firearms must be cleared, actions open, and placed on the window shelf. No handling of firearms when anyone is forward of the firing line. Anyone in the building must be behind the painted safety line on the floor.
14. Inside shooters must always check with shooters at the outside firing points, and vice-versa, before going forward of the firing line.
15. Only paper and/or cardboard targets are allowed.
16. Only target frames made of wood or PVC is allowed and the frame must have the same specifications as the club provided frames.
17. Target bullseyes must be 5 ½ feet above the ground to ensure impact on the backstop.
18. When shooting with a group, it is recommended that someone take charge to run the firing line in accordance with these rules. If a Range Safety Officer is present, that person will handle this function.
19. Observe all posted rules at the range.

Violations of these rules should be reported to the club management. Violators may be dismissed from club membership.

These rules are reviewed annually by each range Committee Chairman. Any suggestions or recommendations to make our club safer should be directed to any member of the club management team.
